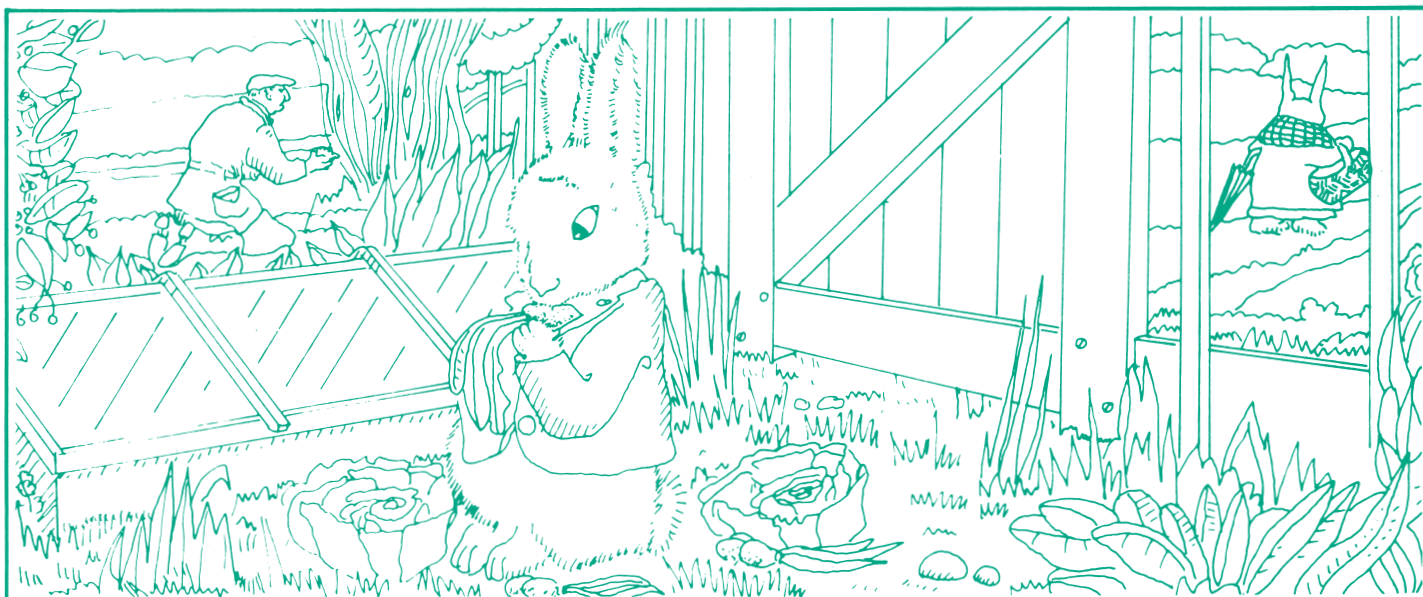


The Tale of Peter Rabbit by Beatrix Potter
