General instructions

This book contains the following three practice papers.

- Biology Paper (25 minutes)
- Chemistry Paper (25 minutes)
- Physics Paper (25 minutes)

It is best to do the papers in the order they appear in the book, but don't do all the tests at the same time. Have a break between tests.

The tests are timed and each lasts 25 minutes.

Before you start a test

- When you are ready to do one of the practice papers, find a quiet place where you can concentrate.
- Have a clock or watch ready. The adult who is helping you should start to time each paper from the moment you turn the page and start reading it.
- Don't cheat by reading the questions before the test, or by looking at the answers. If you do, your score won't be accurate.
- When you are ready to begin, turn to the first page of the test paper.

During the test

- Follow the instructions for each question carefully.
- Think about each question and try your best to answer it.
- This symbol shows where you need to put the answer:
- Remember that for some questions you may need to draw an answer instead of writing one.
- If you cannot answer a question, go on to the next one. If you have time, you can come back to it later.
- If you have time when you reach the end of the test, go back and check your work.

After the test

- The numbers in the right-hand margin of each test page tell you how many marks each question is worth.
- Ask the adult who is helping you to mark your practice paper. The answers and mark scheme are on pages 39 to 46.
