

The $\times 4$ table

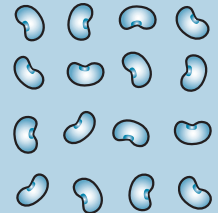
Hard facts

$$3 \times 4 = 12$$

Notice that this fact has digits **1, 2, 3** and **4**. Say aloud the rhyme **3, 4 ... 12 is the same as 3 times 4**.

$$4 \times 4 = 16$$

Think of a square with **4** rows of **4** beans. Whisper the rhyme **4 times 4 beans are 16**.



Use double, double.

$$6 \times 4 = 24$$

6 doubled is **12**. **12** doubled is **24**.

$$7 \times 4 = 28$$

7 doubled is **14**. **14** doubled is **28**.

$$8 \times 4 = 32$$

8 doubled is **16**. **16** doubled is **32**.

$$9 \times 4 = 36$$

9 doubled is **18**. **18** doubled is **36**.

Which dog?
