## The ×4 table

## Hard facts

$$3 \times 4 = 12$$

Notice that this fact has digits 1, 2, 3 and 4. Say aloud the rhyme 3, 4 ... 12 is the same as 3 times 4.

$$4 \times 4 = 16$$

Think of a square with 4 rows of 4 beans. Whisper the rhyme 4 times 4 beans are 16.

Use double, double.

$$6\times 4=24$$

$$7 \times 4 = 28$$

$$8 \times 4 = 32$$

$$9 \times 4 = 36$$

9 doubled is 18. 18 doubled is 36.
