

# The $\times 8$ table

## The hard facts

$$6 \times 8 = 48$$

This fact has the same answer as

$$8 \times 6 = 48$$

Remember you can multiply by 6 by **multiplying by 3** and then **doubling**.

$$8 \times 3 = 24$$

$$\text{Double } 24 = 48$$

$$7 \times 8 = 56$$

Notice that this fact has digits 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Say aloud the rhyme

**5, 6, 7, 8, seven eights are fifty-six.**

$$8 \times 8 = 64$$

Think of a monster with 8 arms.

On each arm of the monster there are 8 claws. Shout the rhyme

**8 arms with 8 claws is 64.**
