The $\times 8$ table

The hard facts

$$6\times8=48$$

This fact has the same answer as

$$8 \times 6 = 48$$

Remember you can multiply by 6 by multiplying by 3 and then doubling.

$$8 \times 3 = 24$$

Double
$$24 = 48$$

$$7 \times 8 = 56$$

Notice that this fact has digits 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Say aloud the rhyme

5, 6, 7, 8, seven eights are fifty-six.

$$8 \times 8 = 64$$

Think of a monster with 8 arms.

On each arm of the monster there are **8** claws. Shout the rhyme

8 arms with 8 claws is 64.
