

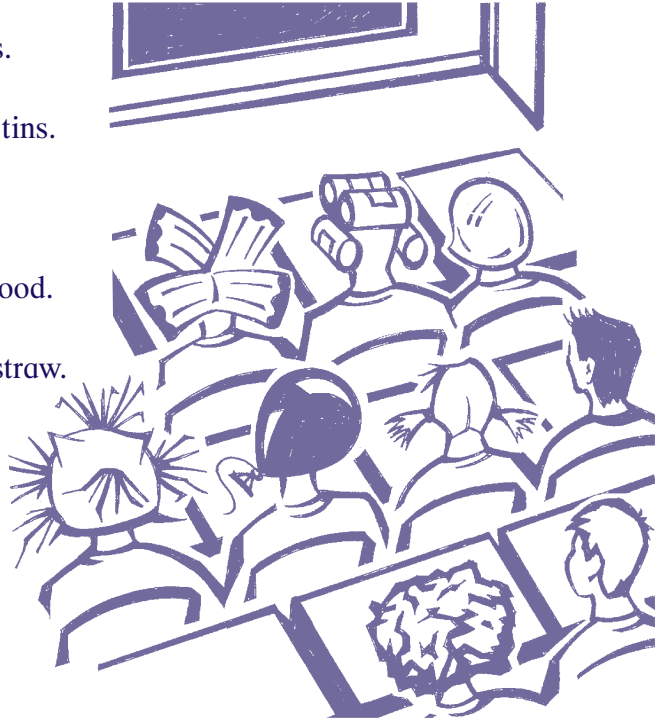
# Odd girls
