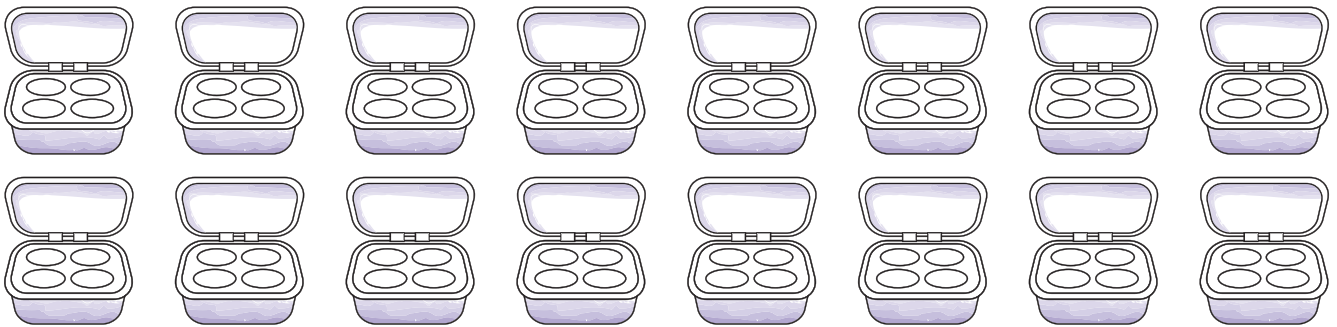

- 8** Write the first **nine** square numbers.

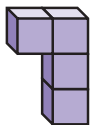
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- 9** Be systematic when solving this problem:
This fruit box has spaces for four peaches. Shade **all** the ways that the box could look if **none, one, two, three or four** peaches are in it.

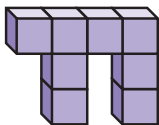

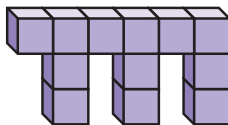

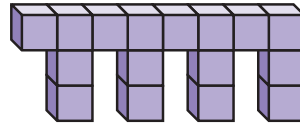
