

Revision 1 answers

Focus: combining words to make sentences; separating words with spaces

Check that the spaces between words are a reasonable size.

The sentences should begin with a capital letter and end with a full stop, as these are given in the question.

Focus: using capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences

Use this activity to remind the children to reread sentences to check for capital letters and full stops. Discuss why the other two sentences are not correct. Let the children 'be teacher' and put in the full stop or capital letter to correct them.

Focus: using capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences

In the second question, check that the capital 'M' at the start of 'Man' has been replaced with a lower-case 'm'.

These pages revise concepts introduced in Section 1. The focus of each activity is given to help identify areas where the children might need further revision.
