

# Using this book

This book contains 40 sets of times tables questions. Each set contains 25 questions worth one mark each and is designed to be completed in two-and-a-half minutes (150 seconds). This matches the pace of the Multiplication Tables Check, which takes place in Year 4.

## What you will need

- a pencil
- an eraser
- a timer or stopwatch

## How to use this book

Make sure you are sitting in a quiet place where there aren't any distractions.

Turn to **Set 1** on page 4. When you are ready to begin, start the timer.

Read each question and write the answer. You should not use a calculator. Work as quickly and as carefully as you can.

When you reach the end of **Set 1**, stop the timer. Use the **Multiplication square** on page 48 to check your answers. Then fill in the **Marks out of 25** and **Time taken** sections at the bottom of the page.

For each set of questions, write your score in the box and colour the chart to show this score.
