There are lots of different words that describe the position or place that something is in. For example: 'below', 'under', 'next to', 'above' and 'on top of'. Ordinal numbers can also be used to describe position or order. For example: 'first', 'second' and 'third'. Always count from the first picture on the left of the sequence to find a picture's position.
