## Remember

The capacity is the amount of liquid a container holds. The units used most often when measuring capacity are litres ( l ) and millilitres ( ml ). There are 1000 millilitres in 1 litre.

Read the scale on the jug at the water level to find out how much liquid it holds. For example: there are 300 ml of water in this jug.
